This is a culture of Sangam schools. Actually this is targeted to South Indian students, however, in this school some North Indian students also enrol into this program. There are some I-Taukei students as well doing the same lessons. This is to learn mul-

tiple languages. We always encourage students to at least know and learn a foreign language apart from their own mother tongue. This Tamil classes and lessons are entirely school based and the curriculum used is outlined

by TISI Sangam. Mrs Palamani is In-charge for all Tamil lessons. Class based assessment is also conducted to gauge out the teaching and learning.
